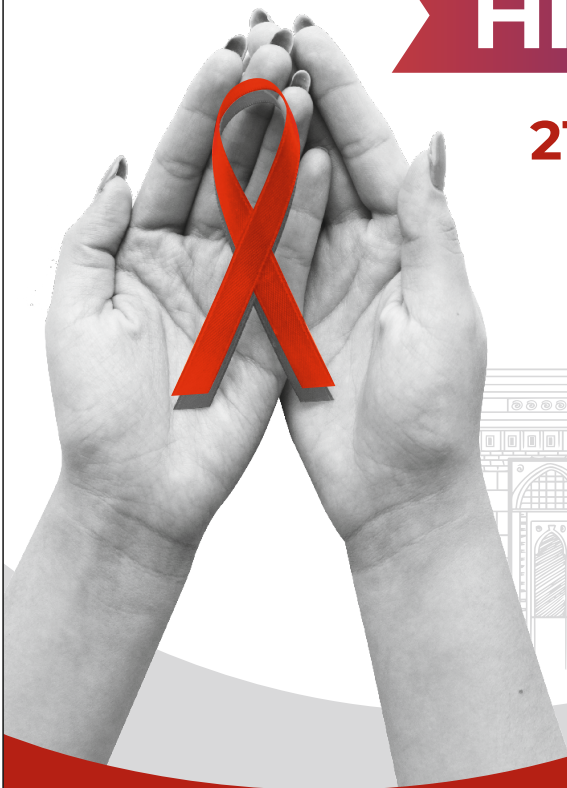

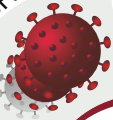

DO NOT include degrees or professional designations. The name of institution, city and country should be in lower case, following immediately after the authors, on a different line.
3. Leave one line between the title / authors / institution block and the body of the abstract.
4. Abstracts should be structured under following headings:
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions

It is not satisfactory to state: "The results will be discussed".

5. The use of standard abbreviations is desirable. Place special or unusual abbreviation in brackets after the full word the first time it appears.
6. Do not include graphs and references in the abstract.
